## KEY POINTS

- The Church in Philippi was started with a converted businesswoman, a demon-possessed slave girl, and a jailer.
- Wherever there is Gospel progress, there will always be resistance.
- Paul's letter to the Church was about 10 years after the account in Acts as he was under house arrest in Rome.
- Paul shares his heart and his appreciation for the people in the body and for their partnership in the Gospel.
- Paul declares that what God starts, He is faithful to complete.
- We should remember Philippians 1:6 before we give up or judge ourselves or others.
