## KEY POINTS

- Paul's third missionary journey ended with imprisonment in Jerusalem.
- The Holy Spirit and a prophet both foretold that Paul would be afflicted and imprisoned if he went to Jerusalem.
- Paul was committed to the will of God. He did not count his own life more worthy than sharing the Gospel.
- Often times of hardships are just opportunities to grow and share the Gospel.
- Living for Christ is real life with real struggles.
- Where there is Gospel progress there will be resistance.

1. Ask yourself who are you living for and what are you living for.
2. Have you ever been in a hard place and found that God used it as an open door to share the Gospel?
3. Paul said that he didn't count his life as precious. Explain the impact that attitude would have on you and your relationships.
