KEY SCRIPTURES

- Philippians 4:10-20
- 2 Corinthians 8:1-9

KEY POINTS

- It is helpful to remember that the letter to the Philippian church was in response to their giving: a "Thank You" letter from Paul.
- Giving is an act of grace that first occurs in us by God's gift of forgiveness.
- Giving becomes a natural outflow of the believer that has received God's grace.
- Our giving is always first unto the Lord and then unto others.
- Giving breaks off entitlement and becomes an expression of gratitude.
- Paul boasted of the generosity of the Philippian church and used their giving to inspire other churches.
- Giving includes forgiving.
- · God's character overflows with giving.

- 2. Discuss the various ways we can give?
- 3. Do you have a testimony of giving then being resupplied to give more?
