KEY POINTS

- Some of us have stumps from our past that need to be removed. These stumps are giving place to the devil and at times producing foul fruit.
- We can co-labor with Jesus to say to these roots/trees/stumps, “Be removed,” by faith in His power and desire to deliver us.
- Bitterness and unforgiveness are in the way of others obtaining grace.
- God desires our hearts to remain tender.
