## KEY POINTS

- The elementary principles listed appear at first to be something to not leave, but they are all related to the Old Covenant.
- Impossible is a strong word, especially as it relates to being restored from falling away. There is a distinction between falling and falling away. Falling away is more than falling into sin. Falling away is to deviate from the truth of salvation through Christ.
- To apply this to ourselves: we are to be sternly warned not to deviate or fall away from the truth.
- God desires us to mature and the evidence of this is fruit.
- God does not overlook our works of righteousness.
- God's promises are secure and proven out over time if we patiently endure.
- We have a hope that is an anchor for our souls. This anchor keeps us holding on to the promises of God and to not fall away during difficult times.
