PETER'S SERMONS

For Pete's Sake October 1, 2023

KEY SCRIPTURES

- Acts 2
- Acts 3:11-16
- Acts 4:1-12
- John 10:7-18

KEY POINTS

- Peter capitalized on the questions of non-believers and skeptics. He used it as an opportunity to explain the Gospel.
- Peter did not soft sell the message.
- Peter's sermons were outlined by the prophecies of the Messiah's coming, His suffering, and His resurrection.
- Peter charged the listeners that they killed Jesus.
- His sermons called the hearers to repentance, to turn from wicked ways, to be baptized, to receive the forgiveness of sins, and the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Thousands were added to the church following these sermons in just a matter of a week.
- The new believers were unified by sharing, praying, serving, breaking bread, and learning about Jesus.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. The early Church was empowered by the Holy Spirit. Can you explain your relationship with the third Person of the Trinity?
- 2. What thoughts do you have when Peter says that we killed the Author of Life?
- 3. What does it look like in your life when you repent?
- 4. When was the last time you spoke to someone you assumed needed to know the Gospel?
- 5. Do you feel qualified to share the Gospel?
- 6. Pray together as a group that the Holy Spirit would empower you to share the Good News.
