KEY POINTS

- Those who fail to honor God or give thanks will end up with darkened hearts.
- A heart of ingratitude stems from "never enough" and "I deserve more."
- A heart of gratitude stems from "I don't deserve anything" and "I expect nothing."
- If one expects nothing, anything more will produce a heartfelt thanks.
- God doesn't need a thank you, but He knows we need to.
- A grateful heart carries over to others with kindness and patience.
- Grateful hearts are not natural; these hearts have been sanctified by the Spirit. We are asked to put these hearts on by being filled with the Spirit.
- The biblical command to be thankful includes being thankful in **all** circumstances.
- When we thank Him amid pain or misfortune, we are reminded that He is present, and we can trust He is good.

PAUL'S MEDLEY OF THANKS
