KEY POINTS

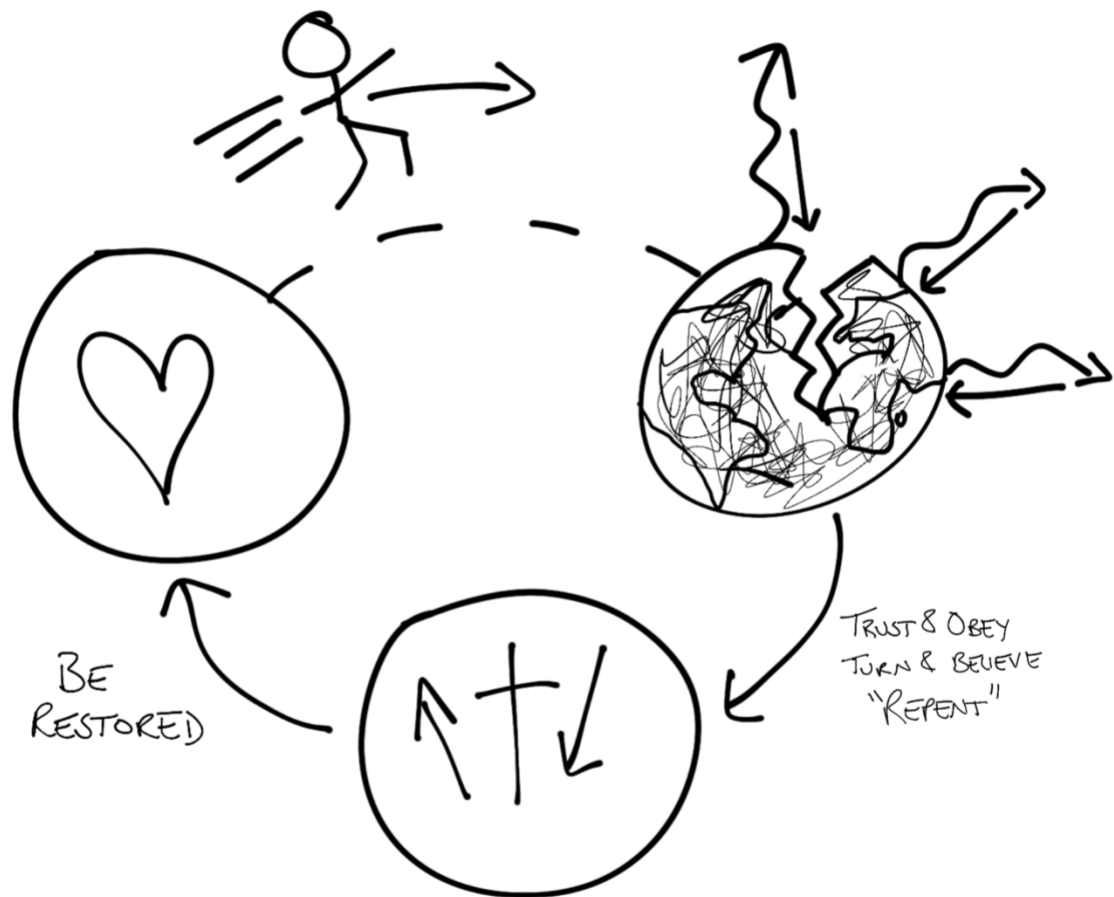
- Christians receive the Holy Spirit at salvation; there's no need to wait for a separate experience. We don't need to wait to start sharing the Gospel.
- Sharing your faith grows your faith—increases joy, maturity, and satisfaction with God.
- The Gospel has supernatural power to transform lives—it's not our power but God's.
- The Word of God never returns void; every seed you plant will fulfill God's purpose.
- Tools for evangelism:
 - 15-second Testimony

 - Napkin Gospel (3 Circles)
- Communion reminds us weekly to live the Gospel and share it.
- We are called to return to the broken world with God's truth, grace, and love.

DISCUSSION

- Take a few minutes to craft your own 15-second testimony using the format: "I used to be ____, but then ____, and now I'm ____." Share your testimony.
- Who is one person you can intentionally share the Gospel with this week?
- All believers have the Holy Spirit. How does this truth impact your view of your ability to share the gospel?

APPLICATION

- **Write your 15-second testimony** this week and share it with at least one person.
- **Practice the Napkin Gospel** with a friend or family member to get comfortable sharing the story of salvation.
- **Ask God to show you** if you're being called to stay, wait, or go in any area of your life—and obey.
